### About Prince Alfred Park Pool

Prince Alfred Park Pool includes a heated 9 lane 50 metre lap swimming pool, there is always at least 4 lanes open for public swimming. It has a shaded splash deck for toddlers and young children to play in and also provides a large shaded grandstand and grassed area to relax upon.

### Getting to Prince Alfred Park Pool

#### Public transport

There are several buses that stop next to or are in close distance from Prince Alfred Park Pool. These include the M20, M50 and 353 routes that travel along Chalmers Street towards the CBD which stop within 50 metres of the entrance to the centre. There are several buses that stop within 5 minutes from the centre on Elizabeth Street and within 10 minutes from Railway Square travelling both towards and away from the CBD.

The closest train stations is Central Station which is 350 metres away. To plan your trip, visit [Transport for NSW](#) or call 131 500.

## Driving or parking

There is no on-site dedicated parking at Prince Alfred Park Pool. There are paid parking areas along Chalmers Street when bus lanes are not in operation, please check signs for timings.

There is also a mix of 1 hour street parking and paid 2 hour stare parking within 5 minutes' walk of the centre on surrounding streets. This can be quite limited and time may be needed to find a suitable parking spot.

## Taxis and private vehicles

There is no designated set down or drop off area for taxis and private vehicles at Prince Alfred Park Pool, though it is possible for taxi drop offs on Chalmers Street 50 metres from the entrance to the centre.

## Entrance

The entrance to Prince Alfred Park Pool is along a smooth concreted path which is only 50 metres from Chalmers Street. There are 3 pathways that lead from Chalmers Street to the entrance. The entrance closest to Central Station involves a shallow incline, whereas the pathway furthest away involves a shallow decline. All pathways are wide and suitable for wheelchair or mobility aid users.

As the pool is situated within Prince Alfred Park, entrance to the pool can also be main via Cleveland Street, which again is along wide smooth pathways.

## Customer service

Prince Alfred Park Pool reception desk is level with and to the left of the entrance to the centre. The desk is not at a wheelchair accessible height but staff will assist in any way possible to promote ease of access.

## Toilets and change room facilities

There are 2 unisex bathrooms and accessible change room, which are open to the public as well as users of Prince Alfred Park Pool to the left of the café at the entrance to the centre.

There are 1 male and 1 female changing rooms and bathrooms available at the centre. These are accessible to the left of the pool after passing through reception and are well signed. Both sets of change rooms have ambulant toilet facilities.

There are also 2 unisex bathrooms and accessible change room facilities to the left of the pool after passing reception. They can be found in the passage way leading to the female change rooms. Both have suitable room to manoeuvre a wheel chair and a seated showering area. Each has a baby changing table. Though there is not a dedicated adult changing table, there is wide low lying bench that can be used for this purpose if required.

### **Lifts, stairs and passageways**

As Prince Alfred Park Pool is all on one level there is no lifts or stairs to access the facilities. There are sets of stairs if wishing to access the grandstand area. All passageways within the centre are wide and accessible for wheel chair users or those requiring mobility aids.

There is ramp access to the swimming pool, and an aqua wheelchair is available if required. Please notify staff if you require assistance in accessing the pool with the aid of the aqua wheelchair.

### **Audio communication**

There is no hearing loop available at Prince Alfred Park Pool.
